
Mila and Grover, Amur leopard cubs, were born in April 2023. This species is the most endangered big cat on earth, with less than 200 in the wild.




We welcomed two critically endangered Western Lowland Gorilla babies, Charlotte and Bo.





Sea Turtle Second Chance Program

We're currently caring for 6 cold-stunned wild Green & Kemp's Ridley sea turtles rescued after washing ashore on beaches of Cape Cod, with the goal of a Spring 2024 release. In the last decade, we've rehabilitated and released 91 sea turtles through this program.

Education Snapshot


- 27,604 students on field trips
